But they can be extremely disabling and have a great effect on the person's friends and family and their ability to work.

Anxiety disorders often respond well to treatment.

The risk that a patient will experience pain if awake is considerably less than this.

However, unless they are given swiftly after intestinal or respiratory infection, the chances of cure are greatly reduced.

Some patients are given injections.

How do anaesthetics work?

Sometimes they only last for a short period, but they may be long-lasting if no help is received.

Compulsive behaviour includes repeated hand washing, following rigid patterns of behaviour, such as putting on clothes in the same order every day or avoiding cracks in the pavement.

The wealth of clinical and research based knowledge that has accumulated, however, makes anaesthesia a safe and well-tolerated process.

If death does not occur at this stage, it will happen a few days when the kidney fails.

Forty million people in West Bengal and Bangladesh are thought to be at risk from arsenic-contaminated water supplies, although studies are continuing into what effect the poisoning is having.

The exact cause is unknown.

This can include behavioural therapy, counselling to find out the cause of the anxiety, relaxation techniques and drugs which control the symptoms or correct chemical imbalances.

These methods are often combined.

These risks are higher for operations such as caesarean section and emergency surgery in very ill patients, and so the overall risk for routine surgery is low.

What causes osteoarthritis?

Aspirin has also been recommended for those embarking on long haul flights because of the increased risk of a clot forming in the leg during periods of prolonged inactivity.

Common obsessions include fear of dirt or germs, a need for absolute tidiness or order and repeated doubts, for example, about turning off electrical or gas appliances.

Most major and many minor operations in the UK are carried out under general anaesthesia where patients are completely unconscious, pain free and unaware of events.

Common phobias include agoraphobia - fear of open spaces, claustrophobia - fear of closed spaces, social phobia and fears of specific objects, such as spiders or snakes.

Gradually the connections between brain cells are lost and eventually many of the cells themselves die.

Your anaesthetist will ask about your past and present health, smoking habits, alcohol consumption and any medicines you are taking.

If you are overweight reasonable loss of weight can be helpful and it is beneficial to cut down alcohol consumption.

Can I improve my health prior to surgery?

While it is not usually a threat in its own right, it may be an indication of a more serious underlying problem.

In some cases this may be caused by disease.

There are several possible reasons for anxiety disorders, including biological and environmental factors such as genetics, biochemical changes in the brain and traumatic life events.

The symptoms can last for an extended period of time, or they may suddenly flare up, and then recede again.

Symptoms of this disease start out as similar to simple flu, but respiratory symptoms rapidly worsen and the patient usually goes into some kind of shock between two and six days later.

More commonly patients may say they feel excessively "sick" after anaesthetics, in which case a plan can be put in place to minimise these side effects.

Swimming is a good sport for patients with spondylitis as it moves the shoulders and hips.

People with severe agoraphobia, for example, may find it difficult to venture out of their homes.

Eventually the stiffness and deformity become irreversible.

The first symptoms of anaemia are tiredness and palpitations.

You should continue any routine medicines unless specifically advised not to.

In some people, it can also affect other parts of the body, including the blood, the lungs, and the heart.

It has also been associated with nervous system disorders - feeling tingling or losing sensation in the limbs - and hearing difficulties.

Physical therapy is widely used, as are alternative therapies such as acupuncture.

The horse serum used in the makeup of some vaccines can also cause anaphylactic shock.

For any routine operation patients are asked not to eat solid food for at least six hours prior to surgery.

An airway device is placed in the mouth even for short anaesthetics and for major surgery a tube is placed into the airway below the larynx.
